Chief Water Treatment Plant Operator

Summary: HUB is seeking applications to immediately fill the position of Chief Water Treatment Plant Operator. Successful applicant will oversee operation, maintenance and compliance sampling/testing for its 3.2 MGD package surface water treatment plant.

Required: This position requires at least 5 years' experience working as a certified water treatment plant operator in a municipal drinking water treatment facility and a Grade III or IV Water Treatment Plant Operator certification through the State of Tennessee. Qualified applicants will also possess a valid Driver's License through the State of Tennessee; have thorough knowledge of principles and practices of municipal drinking water treatment plant operation and of federal and state regulations governing the operation of water treatment facilities; have thorough knowledge of the occupational hazards of the workplace and of necessary safety precautions; have the ability to plan, schedule and direct the work of subordinate operators; have excellent computer (including Microsoft Excel) and communication (verbal and written) skills. Candidate must also be willing and able to work rotating shifts including evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays. Minimum requirement is a high school diploma or GED. Hiring is subject to a background check and drug testing.

Preferred: Preference will be granted to applicants who have previously served as a Chief Water Treatment Plant Operator for one (1) or more years. College coursework is preferred but not required for hiring.
