



Project “Warming the Heart”

“Warming The Heart” is an important way to help the elderly and handicapped in assisting with their heating bills. Individuals can have the opportunity of contributing monies that will help the elderly and handicapped in instances when they may not be able to pay these bills themselves.

Here is how it works:

Harriman Utility Board will pass each donated dollar to the Mid-East Community Action Agency. This agency will distribute the money to those HUB customers needing help in the Roane/Morgan County areas. The plan has been designed so that each dollar(s) individuals donate goes to help someone. No salaries or other expenses will be paid out of these gifts.

Who is eligible to receive help?

Elderly persons 60 years old or older, and handicapped persons who for health reasons cannot pay their full electric bill and those who have recently or temporarily become unemployed. These individuals who are assisted will have no other obvious resource.

How can those who need assistance apply?

Individuals may request an application from the Mid-East Community Action Agency.
